Chains

From the Std. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31, R. 50 E., herein-
before described,

N.89°39'W., on true line, along the S. bdy. of sec. 31,

Over nearly level land thru dense undergrowth.

24.57 The closing corner of T. 25 N., R. 49 and 50 E., herein-
before described.

40.24 On top of small rolling bench, projecting N.,
The Old Std. cor. of T. 26 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E., which
is a juniper post, 4 ins. square, distinctly scribed,
4 ft. long, lying on top of small mound of earth bet-
ween two shallow pits. In center of mound,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 28 ins. in
the ground, for the restored Std. cor. of T. 26 N., Rs.
49 and 50 E., with brass cap mkd:

No timber. Fair grazing.

R. 49 E.,

Over slightly rolling land thru dense undergrowth.

22.04 At a point 40.00 chs. easting from the closing cor. of
secs. 1 and 2 as subsequently determined,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in
the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1 only, with
brass cap mkd:
