

Survey of the South Boundary of T. 25 N., R. 49 E.

Chains

A pinon, 10 ind. in dia., bears N. $68\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W.,

114 lks. dist., marked T25N R49E S31BT.

Land, rolling hills; drainage, S.

Soil, heavy, sandy to clay loam.

Timber, pinon and juniper.

Undergrowth, sage service berry and buck brush.

Good grazing.

West on true line bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over rolling hills, through scattering timber and under-
growth; along a S. slope to,

14.40 Draw, drains SE.; asc. along a NE. slope 115 ft. to,

19.80 Spur, projects SE.; desc. along a SW. slope 20 ft. to,

25.90 Draw, drains SE.; asc. along a SE. slope 70 ft. to,

32.70 Ridge, bears N. 60° E., and S. 60° W., fence on top of
ridge; thence along top of spur,

40.00 On top of a spur,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in dia., 24 ins.
in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone,
for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with a brass cap marked:
