

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE FIFTH STD. PAR. N. thru R. 54 E.

Chains

No accessories to this corner.

Land, level.

Soil; alkaline clay loam; fine texture, 3rd rate.

No vegetation.

REESTABLISHMENT OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF T. 25 N., R. 54 E.

From the cor. of Ts. 23 and 24 N., Rs. 53 and 54 E.,
which is a juniper stake, 2 ft. long, 2 ins. square,
distinctly mkd. as described by the surveyor general,
lying on top of small mound of earth,

North, on retracement line, bet. Rs. 53 and 54 E.,
searching for old corners at 40 chain intervals,

480.00 Record distance, set temp. cor. of Ts. 24 and 25 N.,
Rs. 53 and 54 E., hereafter designated point "A".

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, Ts. 24 and 25 N.,
R. 53 E., which is a juniper stake, 2 ft. long, 2 ins.
square, distinctly mkd. as described by the surveyor
general, lying on surface of ground mid-distant be-
tween faint traces of four pits,

East, on retracement line, bet. Ts. 24 and 25 N.,
searching for old corners at record distances,

373.57 Fall 364 lks. S. of temp. cor. designated point "A".

399.90 Record distance, set temp. cor. of Ts. 24 and 25 N.,
Rs. 53 and 54 E., hereafter designated point "B".

By cardinal offsets, East, 26.33 chs. from point "A"
and North, 364 lks. from point "B",

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 26 ins. in
the ground, for the restored cor. of Ts. 24 and 25 N.,
Rs. 53 and 54 E., with brass cap mkd:
