East, bet. secs. 4 and 33,

Over nearly level land, gentle W. slope, thru scattering undergrowth.

24.00 Base of W. slope of Diamond Mountains, bears N. and S.

28.60 Wire fence, bears N.7°W. and S.7°E., asc. over gradual W. slope, thru dense sagebrush undergrowth.

30.70 Main road, bears N.10°W. to Elko, Nevada and S.10°E. to Eureka, Nevada.

38.30 Small draw, drains S.70°W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and 10 ins. in a mound of stone, for the restored $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 33, with brass cap mkd:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and 12 ins. in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, for the restored cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, with brass cap mkd:
