

Subdivisions of T. 25 N., R. 54 E.

Chains

- 42.00 Small draw, drains SW. to main draw.
Desc. over W. slope.
- 65.30 Dry wash, 4 ft. wide, 1 ft. deep in bottom of Four Mile Canyon, 130 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., drains N.60°W., continue along broken W. slope, desc. 110 ft. to cor.
- 79.90 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.
Land, hilly and broken. General W. drainage.
Soil, shallow gravelly and rocky loam, 3rd and 4th rate.
Undergrowth, sagebrush, rabbit brush.
Timber, small scrub pinon pine and juniper.
Good grazing.
- N.0°01'W., bet. secs. 2 and 3.
Over hilly land thru scattering undergrowth and small scrub timber.
- 2.80 Draw, drains S.80°W., asc. 50 ft. over S. slope.
- 6.00 Point of small spur, projects S.30°W., desc. along W. slope 80 ft.
- 10.00 Small draw, drains S.30°W., asc. 210 ft. over SE. slope.
- 24.00 Ridge, bears E. and W., desc. 140 ft. over N. slope.
- 34.10 Draw, drains N.80°W., asc. 40 ft. over S. slope.
- 40.00 On top of small spur, projecting W.,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 8 ins. in the ground over a cross (x) cut on granite bedrock, and 20 ins. in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap mkd:

- 44.10 Small draw, drains W., asc. 240 ft. over S. slope.
- 61.60 Main spur, projects W., desc. 220 ft. along steep and rocky NW. slope.
- 80.90 Intersect Fifth Std. Par. N., West, 4.79 chs. distant from the Std. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 35, T. 26 N., R.
