79.68 Intersect N. and S. line, 5 lks. N. of the cor. of
secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.

Thence

N.89°50'W., on true line, bet. secs. 4 and 9,

Over rolling W. slope thru scattering undergrowth.

Desc. 100 ft. over rocky W. slope.

20.00 Base of rocky W. slope, bears N.20°W., and SW., con-
tinue over gentle W. slope.

39.84 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in
the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9,
with brass cap mkd:

with brass cap mkd;
