- 40.00 Fall 4 lks. S. of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, hereinafter described. The course of this line is N.89°57'W., and the length is 40.00 chs.
- Thence
- West, with continuous line and measurement,
- 80.61 Fall 1 lk. N. of the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36.
- The course of this line is S.89°56'W., and the length is 40.61 chs.
- From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, West, bet. secs. 2 and 35,
- 40.18 Fall 20 lks. N. of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 35.
- The true course of this line is S.89°43'W., and the length is 40.18 chs.
- Thence,
- West, with continuous line and measurement,
- 80.29 Fall 12 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35.
- The true course of this line is N.89°53'W., and the length is 40.11 chs.
