Retracement Line.

From the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18 on the W. bdy., which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set and extending 12 ins. above the ground, mkd. and wit. as described by the surveyor general,

East, bet. secs. 7 and 18,

40.14 Fall 24 lks. N. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 18, hereinafter described. The true course of this line is S.89°39'E., and the length is 40.14 chs.

Thence East with continuous line and measurement

80.36 Fall 47 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18. The true course of this line is S.89°40'E., and the length is 40.22 chs.

N.0°01'E., bet. secs. 7 and 8,

40.15 Fall 21 lks. W. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 8,

The true course of this line is N.0°19'E., and the length is 40.15 chs.
