

## SURVEY OF THE SOUTH BDY. OF T. 29 N., R. 54 E.

## CHAINS

- Over mountainous land thru scattering undergrowth.  
 Desc. 30 ft. over rocky NW. slope.
- 2.00 Draw, drains N., asc. 70 ft. over rocky NE. slope.
- 9.00 Spur ridge, projects N. from S.20°E., desc. 200 ft. over  
 W. slope thru dense undergrowth.
- 27.89 The cor. of Tps. 28 and 29 N., Rs. 53 and 54 E., previous-  
 ly described.
- Land, mountainous. General N. drainage.
- Soil, shallow gravelly and rocky loam, coarse texture,  
 quartzite and basaltic formation, 3rd rate.
- Undergrowth, sagebrush, yellow top.
- No timber.
- Good grazing.

## SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 29 N., R. 54 E.

- From the cor. of secs. 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of Tp.,  
 N.0°01'W., on true line, bet. secs. 35 and 36,  
 On Governing Section Line,  
 Over rolling mesa land thru dense undergrowth. Desc.  
 gentle N. slope.
- 5.20 Shallow draw, drains N.50°E.
- 13.00 Low spur, projects N.60°E.
- 22.30 Main draw, drains N.70°E., from/ of draws from the SW.,  
 junction  
 W. and NW. at a point 2 chs. West of line.  
 Asc. 30 ft. over rocky S. slope.
- 24.70 Point of spur, projects SW. 2 chs., asc. along very  
 steep W. slope of spur.
- 32.60 Top and South break of rolling mesa, 40 ft. above spur,  
 bears W. and SE., continue over gentle NE. slope.
- 39.80 Small draw, drains S.85°E.
- 40.00 On slight S. slope,  
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in  
 the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, with  
 brass cap mkd:
