Chains

41.00 Draw, 50 ft. below spur, drains NE.; asc. NW. slope.

54.30 Spur, 265 ft. above draw, projects NE.; desc. gentle  
SE. slope.

76.70 Draw, 465 ft. below spur, drains SE.; asc. along SW.  
slope.

79.20 Intersect Nevada- Utah State boundary, S.  $0^{\circ}09'E.$ , 640  
lks. dist., from the 268th. mile post. S.  $0^{\circ}09'E.$ , is  
the true bearing between the 268th. and 270th mile  
posts. At point of intersection

Set iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 20 ins. in  
the ground, on solid rock, surrounded by mound of  
stone, for the closing cor. for secs. 4 and 33, Tps.  
5 and 6 S., R. 71 E., with brass cap marked
