Chains

48.50 Spur, 215 ft. above the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., projects SE.; desc. along gentle E. slope.

72.80 Draw, 160 ft. below spur, drains E.; asc. S. slope.

79.34 Intersect the 1st. Std. Parallel South, at a point S.  $89^{\circ}51'E.$ , 3.51 chs. dist., from the Std.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. for sec. 31, T. 4 S., R 71 E. At point of intersection

Set iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground, on solid rock, surrounded by mound of stone, for the closing cor. for secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap marked
