 66.10 Spur, 360 ft. above Wash, projects SW.; desc. S. slope.
 74.00 Draw, 135 ft. below spur, drains S.; asc. W. slope.

79.46 Intersect the Nevada and Utah State bdy. at a point S.0°11'W., 4.42 chs. dist., from the 266th mile post.

At point of intersection

Set iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground, on solid rock, surrounded by mound of stone, for the closing cor. for secs. 21 and 28, with brass cap marked
