Chains

Land, mountainous, general drainage and exposure S.
 Soil, rocky and gravelly.
 Timber, cedar and pinon.
 Undergrowth, sage, oak and buck brush.
 Fair grazing.

East, on true line, bet. secs. 4 and 9.

The line east from this cor. crosses a deep canyon with precipitous slopes, covered with scattering cedars and pinon timber, and scattering growth of sage and buck brush undergrowth.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., fallson inaccessible cliffs, impossible to set post.

Dist. by triangulation----- 51.57chs.

Dist. by return measurement----- $\frac{1.57}{50.00}$

50.00 Set iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 4 ins. in the ground, on solid rock, surrounded by mound of stone, for the witness $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

51.57 Triangulation point established by triangulation bet. sec. 5 and 8.

N. rim of canyon, bears NW. and SE.; desc. steep E. slope.

64.00 Draw, 400 ft. below rim of canyon, drains SW.; asc. abrupt W. slope.

79.46 Intersect the Nevada and Utah State bdy., at a point N.0°11'W., 182 lks. dist., from the 263rd. mile post.

Set iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. for secs. 4 and 9, with brass cap marked
