Chains.

Land, rolling mountainous.. Soil, sandy and gravelly clay.
Undergrowth, sage and scattering buck brush; fair growth
of grass. Timber, mahogany, juniper and pinon pine.

West, on a true line, bet. secs. 6 and 31, on the S. Bdy.
of the township.

Asc. 20 ft. over rolling mountainous land.

4.10 Top of ridge, bears NW. and SE. Desc. SW. slope 20 ft.

7.00 Head of dry wash, drains SW. Enter dense mahogany, bears
N. and S. Asc. SE. slope 20 ft.

21.80 Top of ridge, bears NE. and SW. Desc. slightly broken
NW. slope 260 ft. to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

27.00 Leave dense timber, bears N. and S.; enter very scattering
juniper and mahogany.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 14 ins. in
the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone 20 ins.
high, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
