

## Survey of the W. Bdy. of T. 14 N., R. 50 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground; for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd:

A pinon pine 4 ins. in diam., bears N.  $61^{\circ}$  E., 38 lks. distant, marked BT only.

A pinon pine 4 ins. in diam., bears S.  $35\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 45 lks. distant, marked BT only.

A pinon pine 5 ins. in diam., bears S.  $36\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  W., 61 lks. distant, marked T14N R49E S12 BT

A mahogany 6 ins. in diam., bears N.  $35-3\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  W., 104 lks. distant, marked T14N R49E S1 BT

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay with exposed ledges on crest of spurs and ridges. Undergrowth, sage, and scattering buck brush; good growth of grass. Timber, pinon pine, juniper and mahogany and scattering clumps of aspen.

North, on a true line, bet. secs. 1 and 6, on the W. Bdy. of the township.

Desc. NE. slope 140 ft. through scattering to medium growth of pinon pine, juniper and mahogany, over rolling mountainous land.

14.00 Dry wash, drains NE. Asc. SW. slope 70 ft.

19.90 Slope changes to E. Asc. 40 ft.

29.80 Top of spur, projects NE. Desc. N. slope 60 ft. over granite outcroppings.

34.00 Dry wash, drains NE. Asc. S. slope 120 ft.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., over cross (x) on granite outcropping, in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 36 ins. high, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
