No other trees available.

Land, rolling general SE exposure and drainage.

Soil, gravelly to sandy loam, 3rd rate.

Timber, juniper.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and shadscale.

Grazing, fair.

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 East on a random line bet. secs. 25 and 36.
40.00 Set a temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

80.00 Intersect the corner of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, which is an iron post, 2 ins. in dia. projecting about 10 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described in the notes of T 14 N, R 52 E. thence,

West on true line bet. secs. 25 and 36,

Over rolling hills, through scattering timber and scant undergrowth.

40.00 On a gentle S slope, level with the sec. cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in dia. 28 ins. in the ground for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. with a brass cap marked:

$$\frac{1}{4} \frac{S25}{S36}$$

Raise a mound of stone N of the post, No bearing trees available.

41.50 Old road, bears NE and SW.

51.50 Wash, 30 lks wide and 10 ft. deep, drains NE.

70.25 Low spur, proj. NE.

73.50 Wash, 35 lks. wide and 5 ft. deep, drains NE.

74.60 Road, Snowball Ranch to Eureka, bears NE and SW.

80.00 The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.

Land, gently rolling hills. SE exposure and drainage.

Soil, rocky, 4th rate.

Timber, widely scattered juniper.

Undergrowth, sage and shadscale- fair grazing.
