

Independent Resurvey of the Third Standard Parallel North
through Range 52 East

Chains

From this point the old standard corner, which is a pinon post, 3 ft. long and 2 ins. square, marked 'SC T XVI N R LII E' on the N face, 'S XXXII on the E face and 'S XXXI on the W face, set in a mound of stone, bears N 79°15' W, 80 lks. dist. I destroy all traces of this corner

Land, rolling hills, general NW exposure and drainage.

Soil, gravelly, 3rd rate.

Timber, juniper.

Undergrowth, sagebrush.

Poor grazing.

West on the S bdy. of sec. 31

Over rolling hills, through scattering timber and scant undergrowth, asc. 105 ft. over broken land to the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

15.40 Dry wash, drains NE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in dia. 27 ins. in the ground for the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31 with a brass cap marked:

SC

Deposit a granite stone, 10x8x6, marked with a cross (X) at the base of the mounment. No trees available for marking and a mound of stone impracticable
No trace of the old standard corner found.

Asc. 170 ft. over broken land to corner.

80.00 On an E slope,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 3 ins. in dia. 14 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone for the Standard corner of Township 16 North, Ranges 51 and 52 East, with a brass cap marked:
