No trace of the old standard corner found.

Desc. 80 ft. along a broken NW slope to the township corner.

77.80 Low spur, projecting N.

80.00 On a SW slope on the N side of a small draw,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 3 ins. in dia. 28 ins.
in the ground for the standard corner of Township 16
North, Ranges 50 and 51 East, with a brass cap
marked:

From which,

A pinon, 3 ins. in dia. bears N 30° 15' W, 06 lks.

dist., marked: 'SCBT' only.

No other tree available for marking.

From this point the old standard corner, which is a
juniper post, marked 'T XVI N R L E XXXVI' on the
N face, 'R LI E XXXI' on the E face and 'SC' on the
S face, set in a mound of stone, bears N 87° 51' W,
836 lks. dist., I destroy all traces of this corner.
Land, low rolling hills, general NW exposure and drainage.
Soil, sandy to rocky loam, 3rd rate.
Timber juniper and pinon.
Undergrowth, sagebrush.
Fair grazing.
