

## South Boundary of T. 10 N., R. 52 E.

Chains

From the corner of townships 9 and 10 north, ranges 51 and 52 east, which is an iron post, 3 ins. dia., as recently established by me under this group and described in notes of T. 10 N., R. 51 E.

East, bet. secs. 6 and 31, along south boundary of T. 10 N., R. 52 E.

Over rolling and low broken land, through medium timber and undergrowth.

8.00 Shallow draw, drains S.60°W.

17.00 Enter more scattered timber.

37.68 (Allowing for convergency) 100 ft. above tp. cor., Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

53.00 Shallow draw, drains S. for 5 chs. thence to SW.

64.00 Low rolling spur, projects SW.

77.68 On W. slope, 200 ft. above  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 24 ins. in the ground, and surrounded with small mound of stone, for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, with brass cap marked

Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and greasewood.
