East, bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over rolling land, through scattered timber and dense undergrowth.

20.00 Shallow wash, drains S.80°E.

30.45 Dry wash, drains S.60°E.

40.00 On a rocky S. slope, 30 ft. below sec. cor.,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
