CHAINS


Land, rolling. Soil, gravelly loam. Timber, none.
Undergrowth, medium sagebrush. Fair grazing.

South, bet. secs. 25 and 30

Over rolling land


21.20 Dry wash, 15 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains E.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 15 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd



At base of post deposit a marked(x) stone 1x3x3 ins.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, with brass cap mkd



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, rolling. Soil, sandy gravelly loam. Timber, None.

Undergrowth, sagebrush. Fair grazing.

South, bet. secs. 31 and 36

Over gently rolling land

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd



No stone available; pits impracticable.

58. 60 Old road and surface wash, bears NW and SE with SE drainage.
