Chains

I remonument this cor. for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. sec. 3 only as follows:-

Alongside of cor. monument.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in

the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., sec. 3 only, with brass

cap marked

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of post.

Thence

N. $0^{\circ} 22' W.$, on true line with continuous measurement.

48.50 Road, brs. N. $30^{\circ} W.$, and S. $30^{\circ} E.$

49.80 Ravine, 30 ft. deep, course SE.

53.50 Point of spur, projects S. $70^{\circ} W.$

58.00 Ravine, course SW.

78.30 Road, in ravine, brs. S. $80^{\circ} E.$, and N. $70^{\circ} W.$; ravine drains SW.

80.99 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 on N. bdy. of Tp., heretofore described.

Land, rolling.

Soil, sandy clay loam mixed with lava and limestone; 2nd and 3rd rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and rabbit brush.

Medium growth of grass affording good grazing.
