


DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T. 17 N., R. 25 E.

Chains

Point for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 falls in old channel of river, which fills with water during flood season, therefore at point N. 88° 48'W., 50 lks. dist. from true point for sec. cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground for witness cor. of cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, with brass cap marked



1925

Deposit broken glass and scrap iron at base of post.

Land, rolling and bottom land.

Soil, loose sandy loam on E. portion and rich sandy loam on bottom land; 1st and 2nd rate.

Undergrowth, medium growth of sagebrush and grass.

Scattering cottonwood on portion of mile.

Good grazing.

From true point for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32. N. 88° 48'W., on true line bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over bottom land, through medium undergrowth

0.50 The witness cor. of cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32.

14.15 Wire fence, brs. N. 10° W., and S. 10°E.

19.10 Right bank of Carson River, brs. N. 80°E., and S. 80°W.; thence across river which drains N. 60°E.

23.50 Left bank of Carson River, brs. N. 60°E., and SW.; thence over bottom land.

24.10 Wire fence, brs. NW. and SE.

29.40 Bank of old river channel, running water in channel, course S. 60°E.; thence across channel.

34.30 Bank of old river channel, brs. N. 60°W., and S. 60°E.

40.56 Proportionate point.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked.
