

RETRACEMENT OF

WEST BOUNDARY OF T. 17 N., R. 25 E.

Chains

- 40.24 Fall 10 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, hereinafter described.
- The course of the N. half mile bet. secs. 19 and 24, therefore is N. 0° 06' W., and the dist. is 40.24 chs.
- From cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24.
- Thence
- North, on retracement line along W. bdy. of Tp.
- 40.00 No evidence of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. found.
- 80.00 No evidence of cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18 found.
- 120.00 No evidence of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 7 and 12 found.
- 160.00 No evidence of cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12 found.
- 199.65 Fall 51 lks. W. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 1 and 6, hereinafter described.
- The course of the line from the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24 to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 1 and 6, therefore is N. 0° 09' E., and the proportionate length of each half mile is 39.93 chs.
- From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 1 and 6.
- Thence
- North, bet. secs. 1 and 6 on retracement line.
- 40.87 Fall 31 lks. W. of the cor. of Ts. 17 and 18 N., Rs. 24 and 25 E., hereinafter described.
- The course of the N. half mile bet. secs. 1 and 6, therefore is N. 0° 26' E., and the dist. is 40.87 chs.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF

NORTH HALF MILE OF WEST BOUNDARY, T. 16 N., R. 25 E.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., bet. secs. 1 and 6, on W. bdy. of T. 16 N., R. 25 E., which is an old cottonwood post, 2 x 2 ins., sq., 18 ins. long, set in old mound of earth. No legible marks on post. Alongside of post set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
