29.90 Right bank of Carson River, brs. N. 70°E., and S. 70°W.;
thence across river which drains N. 70°E.

thence over rolling land.

38.40 Road, brs. E. and W.

28.30 Slough in old channel of river, drains E.

30.20 Road, brs. S. 70°E., and N. 70°W.

40.00½ Proportionate point.
