


DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF NORTH BOUNDARY OF T. 17 N., R. 25 E.

Chains

was originally built around the cor. stone.  
 In center of old mound of stone.  
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 15 ins. in  
 the ground on solid rock and raise a mound of stone,  
 4 ft. base, 1½ ft. high around post, for cor. of  
 secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, with brass cap marked

Deposit a volcanic stone, marked with a cross (X) at  
 base of post.

Land, rolling and rolling hills.

Soil, coarse sandy and rocky loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and grass.

No timber. Fair grazing.

West, on true line bet. secs. 2 and 35.

Descend SW. slope over rolling hills, through a medium  
 undergrowth.

27.20 High water level of the Lahontan Reservoir, brs. NW.  
 and SE.

Land, rolling hills.

Soil, coarse sandy and rocky loam; 3rd rate.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and grass.

No timber. Fair grazing.
