

Retracement of a portion of the E. bdy. of T. 30 N., R. 58 E.

Chains

From the old cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the East Bdy. of the township, North, on retracement, on the E. bdy., making diligent search for old cors none of which were found until at 120.21 Fall 119 lks. W. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 24, hereinafter described.

The course of this line is N. $0^{\circ} 34'$ E., and the proportionate length of each half mile is 40.07 chs.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 24, North, on retracement, bet. secs. 19 and 24.

39.96 Fall 29 lks. W. of the old cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, hereinafter described.

The course of this line is N. $0^{\circ} 25'$ E., and the distance is 39.96 chs.

From the old cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, North, on retracement, bet. secs. 13 and 18,

Dependent resurvey of a portion of the E. bdy. of

Alongside the old cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, which is a granite stone, 8x8x6 ins., firmly set and marked 1 groove on S. face and 5 grooves on N. face, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, with brass cap marked

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor. From this corner, Indian cabins designated as No. 1, bears N. $49^{\circ} 45'$ W.; No. 2, bears N. $46^{\circ} 30'$ W.; No. 3, bears N. $35^{\circ} 45'$ W., No. 4 bears N. $25^{\circ} 15'$ W.; Sam Wine's house bears N. 74° W.
