The course of this mile is N.89°26'W., and the proportionate length of each half mile is 40.07 chs.

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the S. bdy. of T. 30 N., R. 58 E.

The corner of old fence lines from the north and the west has been generally accepted by adjacent property owners as being the true point for the corner of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36. These fence lines are of great age and are reported to have been built when the old corner post marking the corner of sections 1, 2, 35 and 36 was still in place. No evidence remains at this date of the original corner.
