

## Retracement of a portion of the subdivisions

of T. 30 N., R. 58 E.

Chains	From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. , North, on retracement, setting temporary points at 40.00 and 80.00 chs. and making diligent search for old cors. No old corners were found until at a point
120.35	Fall 186 lks. W. of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 26, hereinafter described.

	From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the E. bdy, West, on retracement,
40.00	After diligent search , find no trace of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
79.80	Record distance falls in projection of old N. and S. fence line.
80.73	Fall 24 lks. N. of the temporary point for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.
97.97	Fall 72 lks. N. of the old E. 1/16 sec. cor., hereinafter described.
	The latitudinal position for the reestablished corner of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36 is determined by proportional measurements between the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 and the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 26; the longitudinal position is fixed in the projection of the old north and south fence line which is generally conceded by local settlers to be on the section line bet. secs. 35 and 36. This point is at record distance from the east boundary.
	The course of the line between sections 35 and 36 is N.0°40'E., and the proportionate length of each half mile is 40.12 chs.
	The course of the line bet. the reestablished position for the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36 and the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 26 is N.1°20'E., and the distance is 40.13 chs.
	The course of the line bet. secs. 25 and 36 is West and the proportionate length of each half mile is 39.90 chs.
	The course of the line bet. the reestablished position for the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36 and the E. 1/16 sec. cor. bet. secs. 26 and 35 is S.87°44'W., and the distance is 18.18 chs.
