

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE EAST BDY. OF
T. 28 N., R. 58 E.

Chains

Undergrowth, greasewood, rabbit brush, sagebrush, shad
scale.

No timber. Good grazing; rye and meadow grasses.

North, on true line, bet. secs. 1 and 6,

Over heavily sodded meadow land.

23.40 Leave heavily sodded meadow land and continue over level
land covered with a sparse growth of meadow grasses
and annual weeds with scattering clumps of rabbit brush.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in
the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.

76.55 Intersect the N. bdy. of T. 28 N., R. 59 E. at the temp.
cor. heretofore mentioned.

At point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long,
3 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of
Ts. 28 and 29 N., Rs. 58 and 59 E., with brass cap
marked

Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., on line, N., E., S. and W. of
post, 3 ft. distant.

Land, level.

Soil, alkaline clay loam, medium to fine texture, 3rd

rabbit brush.

Fair grazing.
