Chains

From the reestablished cor. of Ts. 28 and 29 N., Rs. 59 and 60 E., hereinbefore described,  
North, on a random line, bet. Rs. 59 and 60 E., searching for original corners at 40.00 chain intervals.

478.57 Fall 530 lks. W. of the original corner of Ts. 29 and 30 N., Rs. 59 and 60 E., which is a juniper stake, 4 ft. long, 3 ins. square, scribed on four faces, lying on a mound of earth with faint traces of pits in each section. In center of mound, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the re-established cor. of Ts. 29 and 30 N., Rs. 59 and 60 E. with brass cap marked

Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N., E., S. and W. of post, 3 ft. dist.

The true course of this line is N. 0° 38' E., and the proportionate length of the north half mile is 40.25 chs.; the proportionate length of the remaining half miles is 39.85 chs.

From the Twp. cor.,

S. 0° 38' W., on true line, bet. secs. 1 and 6,

Over slightly rolling land thru medium dense undergrowth.
