

SURVEY OF THE CENTER AND PARTITION LINES.

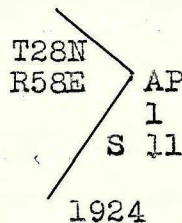
Chains

From the restored meander corner and angle point between
secs. 14 and 15, T. 28 N., R. 58 E., hereinbefore des-
cribed,

N.20°30'E., on true line, over nearly level land thru
medium dense undergrowth,

131.90 Leave medium dense undergrowth of rabbit brush and con-
tinue over meadow land, bears SE. and NW.

108.30 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the
ground, over a broken glass memorial, for angle point,
with brass cap marked



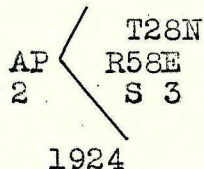
Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., on line, 3 ft. dist.

Thence

N.51°00'W., on true line, over nearly level land thru
scattering clumps of rabbit brush and over meadow land.

51.50 Leave scattering undergrowth and grasses and continue
over barren black clay flat or bottom of old lake bed,
bears N. and SE.

64.00 On small grassy knoll, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1
in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, over a broken glass
memorial, for angle point, with brass cap marked



Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., on line, 3 ft. dist.

Thence

N.6°15'E., on true line, over small grassy knolls and over
barren clay flats.

45.00 On small knoll covered with a medium heavy stand of rabbit
brush and sagebrush and medium heavy rye grass,
