

SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 28 N., R. 58 E.


Chains

West, on true line, bet. fractional secs. 3 and 34,
Over low clay drainage basin covered with reeds and tules.

7.40 Intersect Center Line, N.29°45'E., 4.17 chs. distant from
AP No. 3 hereinbefore described.

At point of intersection,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 28 ins. in
the ground, over a broken glass memorial, for the
closing cor. of Ts. 28 and 29 N., R. 59 E., with brass
cap marked



Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., on lines, 3 ft. dist.

Land, nearly level; low clay flat or basin.

Soil, alkaline clay, 3rd and 4th rate.

Vegetation; reeds, tule and scattering meadow grass.

Poor grazing.

From the cor. of secs. 13 and 14 only, established at a
westing of 80.00 chs. from the reestablished cor. of
secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18 on the E. bdy. of the Twp.,
hereinbefore described,


N. 0°01'W., on true line, bet. secs. 13 and 14,

Over gently rolling land thru dense undergrowth.

5.00 Small drain, course W.

14.10 Leave dense sagebrush undergrowth and continue thru dense
rabbit brush over level land, bears E. and S. of W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the
ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 14, with
brass cap marked



Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.

The old corner stake, a juniper, 2 ft. long, 2 ins.
