

SURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 29 N., R. 58 E.


Chains

40.10 Leave heavily sodded area, extends N.10°W. and E. 10 chs. thence SE., continue over marsh and bottom land thru reeds and tules.

60.05 Intersect Center Line, S.51°00'E., 18.60 chs. from AP No. 2 and N.51°00'W., 25.93 chs. from the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 11.

At point of intersection,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, over a broken glass memorial, for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap marked



Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., on line, 3 ft. dist.

Land, slightly rolling and broken.

Soil, sandy and alkaline clay loam, 3rd and 4th rate.

Undergrowth, rabbit brush.


Good grazing; rye and meadow grasses.

SURVEY OF THE EAST BDY. OF T. 29 N., R. 58 E.

From the cor. of Ts. 28 and 29 N., Rs. 58 and 59 E., North, on true line, bet. secs. 31 and 36,

Over nearly level land thru very scattering rabbit brush and over sodded meadow land.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, over a broken glass memorial, for the 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked



Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, over a broken glass memorial, for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, with brass cap marked
