


SUBDIVISION OF T. 29 N., R. 58 E.

Chains

0 closing cor. of secs. 13 and 18, with brass cap marked



Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., on line, 3 ft. dist.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, clay loam, with heavy gumbo subsoil, 4th rate.

Vegetation, rye and meadow grasses. Occasional clumps of rabbit brush west of line.


Fair grazing.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of the Twp.,

N. 0°01'W., on true line, bet. secs. 35 and 36,


Over gently rolling and nearly level land.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, over a broken glass memorial, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, with brass cap marked



Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., in each sec., 3 ft. dist.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, clay loam, 3rd and 4th rate.

Vegetation, very scattering rabbit brush; rye and meadow grasses.

Fair grazing.
