General Description

Practically all the land in this survey formerly included in the area of the old lake bed, is a nearly level meadow land covered with a good stand of coarse salt and marsh grasses and with various forage weeds. This meadow land is somewhat rolling and broken as it approaches the present low sloughs or drainage basins along the extreme western edge of the surveyed area. Along the eastern edge of the surveyed area, the land is more rolling and is covered with a medium stand of undergrowth consisting of greasewood, rabbit brush, shad scale and sagebrush, and a very poor stand of grasses.

There are no settlers in this area which is adaptable to stock grazing purposes only.
