A pinon pine, 12 ins. dia., bears S. 37° 11' E., 61 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 5 B T.

A pinon pine, 8 ins. dia., bears N. 81° 13' W., 1.98 chs. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 32 B T.

Thence desc. abruptly 215 ft. to


50.00 Base of abrupt descent, bears N. and SW.; thence desc. gradually, 80 ft. to ravine.

Leave scattering timber, bears N. and SW.

Leave mountainous land, enter rolling land, bears N. and SW.

66.70 Ravine, course N. 30° W.; asc. 20 ft. to


