Chains. From the cor. of Ts. 23 and 24 N., Rs. 67 and 68 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. in dia., firmly set, and properly marked and witnessed.

North, on a true line, bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Asc. S.E. slope over rolling land, through scattering cedar and pinon pine timber.

4.40 Dry wash, 10 ft. below twp. cor., course E.

Asc. S.E. slope.

20.00 Top of spur, 30 ft. above wash, projects E.

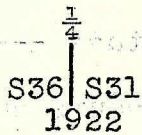
Desc. N.E. slope.

35.00 Dry wash, 10 ft. below spur, course E.

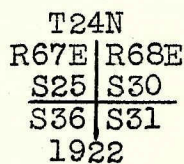

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins.

in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone, and deposit a stone with cross marked (x) at base of post, for the cor. of secs. 25 and 30, 31 and 36, with brass cap mkd.

Undergrowth: medium growth of black sage and bunch grass; scattering shadscale.

Timber, scattering cedar and pinon pine.
