## Chains

From the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, with continuous measurement, retrace S.  $0^{\circ} 01' E.$ , bet. secs. 33 and 34.

79.60 Fall, 10.5 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.  $19^{\circ} 18' 30'' S.$   
The true course of this  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile is therefore N.  $0^{\circ} 10' W.$ , and its length 40.02 chs.

## Survey of Charity Lode.

Beginning at the location monument on the lode line, which is a stake, 2 ft. long, 2 ins. sq., firmly set in a substantially built mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, with the location notice attached. I mark the point further by a nail driven in the hub. Thence S.  $15^{\circ} 13' 20'' W.$ , along lode line.

5.40 Asc. abruptly 134 ft. over rocky broken NE. slope to Top of ascent, bears N. and S.; thence asc. gradually over rolling table land 5 ft. to

11.364 Set temp. point for S. end center of Charity lode.

11.424 Intersect S. end center cor. of Charity lode, which is a substantially built mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 3 ft. high, with notice of location in center of mound.

From this cor. a flag previously erected at the N. end center of Charity lode, bears N.  $15^{\circ} 13' 20'' E.$

From the temp. point for S. end center of Charity lode, previously set,

N.  $74^{\circ} 46' 40'' W.$  on S. bdy. of Charity lode.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. No. 3 of Charity lode, with brass cap mkd.
