

## SURVEY OF FOXY LODGE

## CHAINS

I begin at NE. cor. of Foxy claim, which is a mound of stone on top of large boulder in place, mkd., "NE cor" on top of boulder

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., on top of boulder in place, over a chiseled (x)cross, surrounded by a mound of stone, for cor. 1 of Foxy Lode, with brass cap mkd

S 78° 19' W., on N. bdy. of Foxy Lode

Descend gentle W. slope 25 ft. to

2.30 Dry wash, drains NW. Thence along gentle N. slope.

9.09 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 16 ins. in ground to solid rock, surrounded by a mound of stone, for cor. 2 Foxy Lode, with brass cap mkd

At base of post deposit basalt rock, 4x2x1 ins., mkd

with a (x)cross

Cor. sets at edge of wash, draining N.

No evidence found of old NW. cor. of Foxy claim.

S 4° 56' E., on W. bdy. of Foxy Lode

Ascend gentle N. slope 80 ft. to

13.80 Ravine, drains NW. Ascend steep rocky NE. slope 190 ft.

20.18 SW. cor. of Foxy claim, which is a mound of stone, mkd "SW cor", alongside which I

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., on solid rock outcropping, over a chiseled (x)cross, surrounded by a mound of stone, for cor. 3 Foxy Lode, and Cor. 2 Trixy Lode, with brass cap mkd
