85.02 Intersect the Fifth Standard Parallel North, at a point E. 4.30 chs., distant from the Std.  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor. of sec. 32.

At point of intersection set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, with brass cap mkd.,
