Chains. Land, slightly rolling. Soil, light, gravelly and rocky clay. Undergrowth, sage, shadscale and scant growth of grass.

S. 89° 56' E., on a random line, bet. secs. 1 and 12.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.28 Fall 16 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, which is an iron post, 2 ins. in diam., firmly set, and properly marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 26 N., R. 46 E.

Thence

S. 89° 57' W., on a true line, bet. secs. 1 and 12.

Asc. gradual E. slope over slightly rolling land.

16.70 Top of low rocky butte. Desc. W. slope 100 ft.

30.00 Dry wash, course N.

40.14 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Desc. general SE. slope over slightly rolling land.
