64.80 Dry wash, course N. 30° W.

69.40 Road, bears N. and S.

73.40 Dry wash, course N. 10° W.

79.40 Dry wash, course NW.

79.88 The cor. to secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.

Land, rolling. Soil, light, sandy, gravelly and rocky clay loam. Undergrowth, medium growth of shadscale, scattering growth of sage and scant grass. No timber.
