40.00 After diligent search failed to find any traces of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Set temp. point.

✓ 79.99 Fall 28 lks. S. of the old SE. cor. of T. 28 N., R. 46 E., which is a porphyry stone, 18 x 10 x 6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, with no evidence of markings.

✓ The course of this mile is S. 88° 26' E. and the dist. is 80.02.

✓ The course of the line bet. the old cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34 and the old SE. cor. of T. 28 N., R. 46 E. is S. 89° 54' E.

Retracement of a portion of the E. Bdy. of sec. 36.,
T. 28 N., R. 46 E.

From the old SE. cor. of T. 28 N., R. 46 E., hereinbefore described, North, on retracement, on the E. Bdy of sec. 36.

17.74 Intersect the old closing cor. of T. 28 N., R. 47 E., which is a quartzite stone, 18 x 12 x 8 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, marked with 6 grooves on N. and E. faces.

✓ The course of this line is North and the dist. is 17.74 chs.

Retracement of a portion of the S. Bdy. of sec. 31,
T. 28 N., R. 47 E.

From the old closing cor. of T. 28 N., R. 47 E., hereinbefore described, East, on retracement, on the S. Bdy. of sec. 31.

✓ 80.80 Fall 12 lks. N. of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a quartzite stone, 15 x 10 x 6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face.

The course of this line is S. 89° 55' E. and the dist. is 80.80 chs.
