

## Survey of the E. Bdy. of T. 27 N., R. 46 E.

Chains

From the cor. of Ts. 26 and 27 N., Rs. 46 and 47 E.,  
which is an iron post, 3 ins. in diam., firmly set  
in a mound of stone,

North, on a true line, bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Asc. SE. slope over slightly rolling land.

5.00 Top of low spur, projects E. Continue along general  
E. slope.

21.40 Top of low spur, projects NE. Desc. NW. slope 90 ft.

28.30 Dry wash, course NE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins.  
in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of  
the cor.

40.50 Shallow dry wash, course E. for about 10.00 chs. thence  
NE. Desc. along NE. slope 150 ft.

71.20 Dry wash, course NE. Continue descent 50 ft. along N.  
slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins.  
in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and  
36, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of

Land, slightly rolling. Soil, light, sandy, gravelly  
and rocky clay. Undergrowth, sage, shadscale and scant  
growth of grass.

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North, on a true line, bet. secs. 25 and 30.

Desc. gradually over slightly rolling land.

20.80 Shallow wash, course NE.
