

RETRACEMENT OF PORTION OF BOUNDARY OF SEC. 15, T. 30 N., R. 47 E.

CHAINS I begin at cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23, which is a 2 in. iron post, firmly set in the ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General

Thence

West on retracement line bet. secs. 15 and 22

39.98 Intersect 1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 15 and 22, which is a 1 in. iron post, firmly set in the ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General

Thence

East, on true line bet. secs. 15 and 22

14.39 Intersect W. bdy. of Big Ox Lode N 8° 05' E., 4.25 chs. from cor. No. 3, hereinafter described

23.24 Intersect E. bdy. of Big Ox Lode N 5° 01' E., 5.96 chs. from Cor. No. 4, hereinafter described

39.98 Cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23

SURVEY OF BIG OX LODE.

I begin at NE. cor. of Big Ox claim, which is a mound of stone, marked "NE, cor.", alongside which I

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 4 ins. in ground on solid rock outcropping, over a chiseled (x)cross, surrounded by a mound of stone, for cor. 1 of Big Ox Lode, with brass cap mkd.

N 79° 02' W., on N. bdy. of Big Ox Lode Ascend rocky SE. slope 35 ft. to

3.00 Descend SW. slope 20 ft. to

7.87 NW. cor. of Big Ox claim, which is a rock in place, mkd "NW. cor.", on top of which

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., on rock in place, over a chiseled (x)cross, surrounded by a mound of stone, for cor. 2 of Big Ox Lode, with brass cap mkd
