Chains.

- 45.00 Top of spur, projects W. Desc. NW. slope 80 ft.
- 50.20 Dry wash, course NW. Desc. 280 ft. along general NW. slope.
- 68.10 E. fork of Granite Creek, course SW.; running water, 1 lk. wide, 1 in. deep. Asc. S. slope 100 ft.
- 76.30 Top of low spur, course SW. Desc. gradual W. slope.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of the cor.

Land, rough and broken mountainous. Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky clay. Undergrowth, medium growth of sage and scant growth of grass.

- 40.00 Set temp. ¼ sec. cor.
- 79.76 Fall 28 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 13 and 24, on the E. Bdy. of the township, which is an iron post, 2 ins. in diam., firmly set and properly marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 47 N., R. 34 E. Thence
- N. 89° 46' W., on a true line, bet. secs. 13 and 24. Desc. SW. slope 400 ft. over broken mountainous land.
- 20.60 Dry wash, course SW. Continue descent of general S. slope 110 ft.
- 36.30 Dry wash, course S. 30° W.
- 39.88 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
