

## Survey of the subdivisions of T. 47 N., R. 33 E.

- Chains  
66.10 Fence bears NW. and SE. Desc. along gradual S. slope.  
88.44 Intersect the W. Bdy. of the twp., at a point, North,  
16.60 chs. dist. from the cor. of secs. 24 and 25,  
T. 47 N., R. 32 E., hereinafter described. At the  
point of intersection set an iron post, 3 ft. long,  
2 ins. in diam., 22 ins. in the ground, to solid rock,  
in a mound of stone, for the closing cor. of secs. 19  
and 30, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit a volcanic stone, 8 x 6 x 4 ins, with cross  
marked (x), at base of post.

Land, broken and mountainous. Soil, sandy, gravelly and  
rocky clay. Undergrowth, medium to dense growth of  
sage and fair growth of grass. Aspen, willows, choke-  
cherry and buck brush along Kings River.

- From the cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30,  
N. 0° 04' W., on a true line, bet. secs. 19 and 20.  
Desc. N. slope 130 ft. over broken mountainous land.
- 4.90 Dry wash, course W. Asc. SW. slope 100 ft.  
13.90 Wire fence bears NE. and SW. Asc. 50 ft. along W. slope.  
17.40 Dry wash, course W. Asc. S. slope 440 ft.  
37.40 Top of ridge, bears N. 80° E. and S. 70° W. Wire fence  
bears SE. and NW. Desc. N. slope 10 ft.  
40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 8 ins.  
in the ground, to solid rock and 28 ins. in a mound  
of stone, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
