

## Survey of the subdivisions of T. 47 N., R. 33 E.

Chains.	Deposit a volcanic stone, 12 x 8 x 6 ins., with cross marked (x), at base of post. Desc. NW. slope 400 ft.
52.50	Kings River, course S.; running water, 7 lks. wide, 6 inches deep. Dense aspen, willows and chokecherry along river bottom. Asc. abrupt E. slope 510 ft.
70.00	Top of ridge, bears N. and S. Desc. W. slope 210 ft.
80.04	The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8. Land, rough mountainous. Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky clay. Undergrowth, medium to dense growth of sage and scant growth of grass. Timber, aspen, willows and chokecherry.
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	West, on a true line, bet. secs. 6 and 7. Desc. W. slope 130 ft. over rough mountainous land.
4.50	Dry wash, course S. 10° W. Asc. SE. slope 620 ft.
33.10	Top of divide, bears N. and S. Desc. SW. slope 50 ft.
40.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

	Deposit a volcanic stone, 7 x 5 x 4 ins., with cross marked (x), at base of post. Desc. SW. slope 310 ft.
64.00	Dry wash, course N. 70° W. Desc. 100 ft. along N. slope.
74.30	Asc. N. slope 30 ft.
84.40	Top of low spur, projects NW. Desc. SW. slope 60 ft.
88.07	Intersect the W. Bdy. of the township, at a point, North, 16.43 chs. dist. from the cor. of secs. 1 and 12, T. 47 N., R. 32 E., hereinafter described. At the point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 10 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for the closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, with brass cap mkd.
