General Description of T. 47 N., R. 33 E.

The land in this township ranges in elevation from approximately 5000 ft. in the southern part of the township to approximately 7500 ft. in the northern part. A fractional part of secs. 1 and 12 lies on the Quinn River slope and a fractional part of secs. 6 and 7 drains in a northwesterly direction into Oregon. The remaining portion of the township drains to Kings River.
